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#### **North Superior Traffic Calming Petition Approved by Board of Commissioners**

The DeKalb County Board of Commissioners examined and approved the North Superior Avenue traffic calming petition at their meeting on June 26<sup>th</sup>.

The North Superior traffic calming plan calls for the installation of 2 speed tables and 3 planted median dividers to be installed. One speed table will be placed just north of the city/county line in the 500 block of N. Superior and one speed table will be placed just south of the intersection with Desmond Drive in the upper 700 block of N. Superior.

Three planted median dividers will be built, one in each of the 500, 600 and 700 blocks. Each of the three planted median dividers will be approximately 10 feet wide and 30 to 40 feet long. The planted median dividers will have a poured cement perimeter and be site-designed as to not impact driveway ingress and egress. The County will supply the planting soil for each of the planted median dividers.

Neighborhood residents can expect to see the speed tables installed by the end of July 2006, and the planted median dividers installed by the end of September 2006. The speed tables will be installed in one day. The planted median dividers will take 3 – 5 days to install as they require significantly more labor and material.
